



ISAM Certification Maintenance

The ISAM provides you with 24 hours of training that you can self-submit to meet CPE requirements for your other certifications. There is no annual fee to maintain the ISAM certification. However, 24 hours of continuing education are required annually to maintain your ISAM certification. This requirement can run in conjunction with your CPE requirements for the ISRM or other certifications requiring CPEs.

Basic Requirements for ISAM certification maintenance

- Certificate holders shall complete 24 hours of continuing professional education.
- Reporting Period: Annually – based on ISAM certification date
- Qualifying Programs
Programs which contribute to the member's professional competence and are formal programs. No specific subject areas are required. Examples of qualifying programs are in-house training courses, trade association conferences or college and university classes, other certifications.

- ISATRP.ORG
Your name can be listed at isatrp.org as an ISAM Certified Individual should you choose. It is your responsibility to keep the ISATRP program updated on your contact information should this information change.
- Documentation and Record Retention
Responsibility of documenting compliance with CPE requirements falls on the ISAM certificate holder. For each program the member should be able to document the following:
 1. Title and description of content
 2. Date(s)
 3. Location
 4. Number of contact hours
